摘要

希羅審議式修辭具五大要素：面對公會、審議未來、訴諸利益、運用例證、城邦合一。本文以此五大要素檢視保羅之七封書信——《羅馬書》、《哥林多前書》、《加拉太書》、《以弗所書》、《腓立比書》、《歌羅西書》及《腓利門書》，探究保羅書信是否從屬審議式修辭。

Abstract

The deliberative rhetoric of the Greco-Roman World commonly consists of five different characteristics: speaking to the assembly, concerning the future, appealing to advantage, utilizing examples, and urging for unity. This paper will use these five characteristics to examine seven letters of Paul – Romans, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, and Philemon – and determine whether these letters belong to the genre of deliberative rhetoric.
